The Temple of Ramesses II in Abydos Ogden
Goelet 2022-04-12 Of all the enormous
monuments throughout Egypt and Nubia that
Ramesses II (the Great; ca. 1279-1212 BCE) left
behind, his temple at Abydos, built early in his
reign, stands as one of his most elegant, with its
simple architectural layout and dramatic and

known for its dramatic reliefs depicting the
battle of Kadesh, the temple also offers a wealth

ritual events in the Egyptian religious calendar during the Ramesside period; the promotion of an active, unbound form of Osiris; and the evidence for important cult activities that took place on the rooftop of the temple, the presence of which is documented today by the staircase that accessed it from Court B.
